You are cordially invited to the ARLIS/NA MOQ Fall meeting which will be held at the Bibliothèque centrale of the Université du Québec à Montréal on November 6th 2015. Registration will take place in the A-M204 conference room, located at the metro level in the Hubert-Aquin pavilion starting at 8:30 am.

The meeting will be held in the same location in the Bibliothèque centrale. Following the meeting we will walk to the Galerie UQAM where the artist Hank Bull will present his work in the exhibition *Connexion*. The exhibition transforms the personal archives of the artist, covering a period of over fifty years, in a sculptural installation. Neither a retrospective nor an archive exhibition, *Hank Bull. Connexion* rather seeks to make sense of the materials gathered by the artist throughout his career and highlights an artistic practice based on collaboration.

For lunch, a short walk will bring us to Menthe et Couscous for a family-style meal with vegetarian options. At 2pm, the director of the Centre de design, Börkur Bergmann, will give us a sneak preview of the exhibit *Une architecture du Québec moderne, 1958-1974*. This exhibit will emphasize the architectural practice as a strategy and research process, with its leaps and successes, while presenting significant objects from the firm. At the end of this activity, other exhibits at the Galerie UQAM and in the Ecole de design will be available for you to visit independently to bring our day to a close.

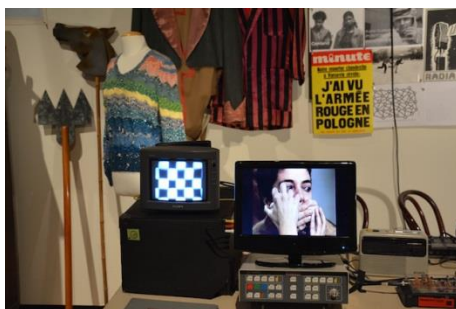
